### What is Community Solar?

Community solar is making solar available to more people than ever before, allowing you to have clean solar energy without the hassle and expense of constructing an individual system on your rooftop. Clean Energy Collective constructs arrays of solar panels, called "solar farms" or "solar communities", in centralized locations. CEC takes care of all the maintenance and repair. WH Solar Community subscribers receive the same financial benefits as if the panels were installed on their roofs, and are credited directly

on their monthly WH electric bills for the power their panels produce.

### Community Partner Program

CEC's Community Partner Program encourages community organizations and individuals to work with CEC to promote community solar. In exchange, CEC's Community Partners receive a percentage of each sale that they help generate. The Community Partner program is open to any organization or individual who works within
