Key Responsibilities:

Working with the Structured and Corporate Finance teams, the analyst will support all aspects of developing and closing solar project investments. The analyst will focus on financial modeling to assist in vetting new project and market opportunities conducting research vital for forecasting, as well as have an active role in weekly reporting and analysis. The analyst will control and update financial models throughout the development and financing of community solar projects.
